Here are some handy tips and tricks for applying and interviewing with Stocksy.*

Applying...

- Give the job posting a good thorough read. Double check you meet the basic qualifications of hours, availability, language, location for the role. We're a co-op with a diverse international team so the requirements vary big time for each role.
- Make sure your application stands out. We receive many, many applications for each role. Take a bit of time on the design/layout of your CV or resume. Use photos, videos, emojis or whatever helps it stand out from the crowd.
- Submit as PDF so it's easy to read and the formatting doesn't go all wonky.
- Take out the guesswork. Customize your application to line up with the requirements/qualifications of the role.
- Take some time to write a cover letter or intro. Let us know who you are, why you're interested in the role and why you think you're a fit for our team of creative geniuses.
- Attach links to portfolios/websites/social media so we can get to know you better.

Interviewing...

- If you're doing a video/phone interview, aim to find a quiet/private space to take the call. Check your sound and WiFi connection ahead of time so we don't go all matrix'y.
- Take some time to learn about us. We want to know what makes you passionate about joining a unique team of relentless creatives working together to elevate the stock world. Our website, blog and social media are great places to start.
- Be prepared to answer questions about hours, availability, start date and yes, even salary expectations.
- Have some questions prepared for us. You're interviewing us as much as we're interviewing you. The fit's gotta work both ways.
- Let us know what makes you, you. Tell us your hidden talent. Your mastery of five languages. Finding the right cultural fit is what we're all about.
